### Your Expert Speakers/Topic Highlights

**Colin Clark** is the State Shoreland Zoning Coordinator, Maine Dept. of Environmental Protection. When not knee deep in one of Maine's trout streams or chasing the fastest and steepest rollercoasters around the country, he can be found working with the municipalities around the state of Maine assisting with administering and enforcing the shoreland zoning rules. Colin has been with the DEP for almost 25 years, starting as an Air Bureau inspector then moving on to the field services group in the Land Bureau and now the State Shoreland Zoning coordinator. His educational background consists of a BS in Resource Economics and Environmental Policy from the University of Maine at Orono. *This class will provide a basic understanding of the shoreland zoning rules, including shoreland zoned resources, nonconforming structures expansions, dimensional requirements, setbacks and vegetation removal.*



**Jessica Damon** is the Director of Licensing Division, Bureau of Land Resources, Maine Department of Environmental Protection. Jessica has been with the Land Bureau in the Department of Environmental Protection for over 20 years and currently oversees the Licensing Division. Prior to joining the Department, she served two years in the Peace Corps in West Africa. Her education background includes a Bachelor of Science in Wildlife Biology from the University of Vermont and a Master of Education with a concentration in Environmental Education from the University of Maine. *This session's objective will be to provide an overview of the Natural Resources Protection Act and recent updates to regulations.*



**Sue Baker** is the Coordinator for the Floodplain Management Program in the Maine Office of Community Affairs. Sue has spent most of the last 30 years working in the Program, becoming the State Coordinator in 2008. She belongs to the Association of State Floodplain Managers, the largest professional group of floodplain managers in the country, and through them, she has been a nationally Certified Floodplain Manager (CFM) since 2000.
