## **Our Expert Speakers**

**Amanda Lind** of Blue Marble will introduce the practical use of Global Mapper for Surveying applications. She will cover methods for combining data, including multiple types or from multiple sources, and managing Projection and Coordinate Conversion. Field data collection with a GNSS receiver is easy with the Global Mapper Mobile application. This will also cover data creation and analysis tools, such as contour lines and breaklines generation. For those interested in 3D data, she will also briefly explore creating 2D aerial orthoimages and 3D data from drone-collected imagery, and point cloud processing.

**Andrew Jacques** of Owl's Eye Media will offer insight on 3D capture technology services, use cases and share his experiences using it over the last 9 years. Andy is a real estate photographer with an appreciation for fine details and is featured by Snappr as one of the best photographers in Portland.

**Robert G. Rogers** will discuss his research project regarding "Fee versus Easement status of Abandoned Railroad rights of way". He is enrolled in the University of Maine's Master of Science in Engineering Technology (MSET) program with a concentration in Surveying Engineering. He has an interdisciplinary Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Maine at Farmington (1995). Since completing his undergraduate degree, he has worked at a mapping firm, a GIS consulting firm, and is currently conducting his own small business in cadastral mapping while teaching computer aided design. Mr. Rogers is a Certified Maine Assessor and plans to gain licensure as a Maine Professional Land Surveyor.
